said Senator Lt Gen Abdul Qayyum while addressing British MPs in the Margret Thatcher Committee Room in the West Ministerial, House of Commons.

It was presided over by British MP Mr James Frith and attended interalia by over dozen British MPs including Rt Hon Sir James former Home Secretary and Foreign Secretary ,

Aimr Yaseen MLA, Naz Shah MP and Mr Afzal MP. Senator Dr Humayun and Mr Bakhtavri Chairman D Watson also attended the conference.
